STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Exempt Electricity Used for Home Heating Purposes from the Sales Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSA, § 1760, sub-§ 36, is enacted to read:

36. Electricity used for home heating. Electricity when used for heating the principal dwelling of a customer of an electrical utility.

FISCAL NOTE

It is estimated that passage of this bill would result in a loss to the State of \$245,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1976 and \$270,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1977.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act will exempt from the sales tax electricity used for home heating purposes.
