STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Remove the Sales Tax Exemption for Fuels for Burning Blueberry Lands.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: 36 MRSA, § 1760, sub-§ 9-A, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 594, is repealed.

FISCAL NOTE

It is estimated that passage of this bill would result in a gain to the State of \$35,000 during the next biennium following passage.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act will repeal the sales tax exemption for fuel used to burn off blueberry fields.
