STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting with Bow and Arrow.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA, § 2502, first ¶, last 2 sentences are repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

If a person does take a deer with bow and arrow during the special season provided in section 2501, he is not precluded from hunting for deer during the regular open season providing he is licensed in accordance with section 2401.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This would permit a person who kills a deer with bow and arrow to hunt during the regular deer hunting season. This should create more interest and promote archery hunting.
