COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 438, L. D. 539, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for a Booth License under the State Barber Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end of the 4th line, before the period, (3rd line in L. D.) the following 'if operated under a booth rental agreement or other rental agreement'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exclude from the definition of "employment" services performed by individuals who are barbers renting facilities in barber shops.
