COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 433, L.D.
544, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Use of Studded
Tires on Motor Vehicles."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the
3rd line the underlined word "trailer"
(same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof
the underlined words 'combination of vehicles'

Further amend said Bill by inserting
at the end of section 1 the following
underlined sentence:

'The permit shall always be carried on the
person of the operator or occupant, or in
some easily accessible place in or about the
vehicle therein described.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to
clarify the definition of vehicle type and
to require the permit to be with the vehicle
operating under the permit provision.
