HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 437, L.D. 545,  
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Education and  
Training under the Laws of Barbering."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything  
after the amending clause of section 3 and  
inserting in place thereof the following:

'3-A. Education. Who has successfully  
completed the 10th grade of high school or its  
equivalent;

Sec. 4. Applicability. Notwithstanding  
any provisions of section 1 of this Act, no  
school of barbering approved by the State Board  
of Barbers shall be required to impose upon any  
student enrolled in a course of instruction on  
the effective date of this Act a minimum  
requirement of a course of study of more than  
1500 hours distributed over a term of not less  
than 9 months.

The provisions of section 2 of this Act  
shall not apply to any person who, by the  
effective date of this Act, has obtained a  
certificate of registration under Title 32,  
chapter 7, to practice barbering, or who, on the  
effective date of this Act, is enrolled in a  
course of instruction of 1500 hours distributed  
over a term of not less than 9 months in a  
school of barbering approved by the State Board  
of Barbers.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment exempts from the increased  
requirements of this Act all persons who have  
received their barbering certificate by the  
effective date of this Act and all persons who  
are enrolled in a course of instruction in a  
barbering school approved by the State Board  
of Barbers.

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This amendment also reduces the educational requirement from graduation from high school to completion of the 10th grade in high school.
