STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Expenditures of the Town Road Improvement Fund.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 23 MRSA, § 1705, first sentence, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 168, is further amended to read:

The expenditures of this fund shall not exceed the sum of \$12,000 \$15,000 in any one mile.

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall become effective July 1, 1976.

FISCAL NOTE

It is estimated that passage of this Act will cost the State \$75,000.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the maximum that may be spent from the Town Road Improvement Fund in any one mile from \$12,000 to \$15,000.

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
