AN ACT Making Supplemental Appropriations to the Department of Health and Welfare for the Provision of Technical Planning, Research and Analysis Capability within the Department of Health and Welfare.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated to the Department of Health and Welfare the sum of \$70,793 to carry out the purpose of this Act, to enable the Department of Health and Welfare to establish methodology for management information, research and evaluation systems to be used statewide and to conduct studies to determine community needs for services and make recommendations as to the distribution of services to meet those needs.
