HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 450,
L.D. 557, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Special Free License Plates
for the 100% Disabled Veteran."

Amend said Amendment by striking out everything after
the Title and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and
inserting in place thereof the following:

AN ACT to Permit Certain Veterans to Obtain Special License Plates
for Handicapped Persons.

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after
the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §251, as amended by PL 1967, c. 25,
is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

§251. Amputee; blind veterans

A veteran who is an amputee or who is blind shall be
considered handicapped for the purposes of section 252.

Sec. 2. 29 MRSA §252, ^{2nd ¶,} ~~as~~ enacted by PL 1967, c. 218,
§1, is ~~amended~~ → amended by inserting after the first sentence
the following:

An amputee veteran or blind veteran shall be considered a handicapped
person for the purposes of this section. An amputee veteran
or a blind veteran shall not be required under this section to
present a physician's certificate of his physical disability as a
condition for issuance of a set of special designating plates
authorized under this section.'

This amendment permits veterans who are amputees or who are blind to obtain special license plates for the handicapped and exempts those veterans from the requirement of a physician's certificate of disability in order for them to get a set of special license plates.
