HOUSE AMENDMENT"C"to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT"A"to H.P. 450, L.D. 557, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Special Free License Plates for the 100% Disabled Veteran."

Amend said amendment by inserting at the end of the first paragraph, before the period, the following: 'and Organizations'

Further amend said amendment by inserting after the 2nd paragraph the following:

'Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §192-A is enacted to read: §192-A. Special initial license plates for certain orgainizations

Upon receipt of an appropriate petition signed by 250 or more adult members of a nonprofit corporation or association, the Secretary of State shall design and issue special initialtype registration plates for use on passenger automobiles and on pickup trucks owned by adult members of that organization. The Secretary of State shall charge a fee of of \$10/ in addition to the regular registration fee, for issue of any set of special registration plates under this section.'

Further amend said amendment by striking out in the beginning of the 3rd paragraph the following: "<u>Sec.1.</u>" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'Sec. 2.'

Further amend said amendment by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

## 'Fiscal Note

Depending upon the number of organizations interested in this statutory provision, this amendment could potentially produce hundreds of thousands of dollars annually over the expenses to

the Secretary of State caused by the issuance of special initial-type plates under the amendment.'

Further amend said amendment by renumbering sections to read consecutively.

## Statement of Fact

This amendment provides for the Secretary of State to issue special license plates to adult members of an organization presenting him with an appropriate petition signed by 250 or more adult members of that organization.
