COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 453, L. D. 559, Bill, "AN ACT Increasing Certain Permit, Examination and License Fees for Hairdressers and Providing for Biennial Renewal of Certain Licenses."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out in the 5th line (4th line in L.D.) the underlined figure "\$50" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$35'

Further amend said Bill in section 5 by striking out in the 6th line (5th line in L.D.) the underlined figure "\$50" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$35'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to decrease the highest allowable biennial license fees to \$35 from \$50.
