HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
H.P. 464, L.D. 566, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase Certain Hunting
and Fishing License Fees."

Amend said Amendment in section 3 in the 13th line
by striking out the underlined figure "\$12.50" and inserting
in place thereof the underlined figure '\$11' and in the 15th
line by striking out the underlined figure "5.50" and
inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$4.50'

Further amend said Amendment in section 8-A by striking
out all of paragraphs A and B and inserting in place thereof
the following:

'A. Resident junior hunting 10- 16 <u>18</u> years of age.	\$1-50	<u>\$1.75</u>
'B. Resident hunting 16 <u>18</u> years of age or older.	\$6-50	<u>\$8.50</u>

Further amend said Amendment in section 8-A by striking
out all of paragraph F and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'F. Nonresident <u>citizen</u> big game hunting Permits hunting for all species including bear and deer.'	\$46-50	<u>\$65.50</u>
