Amend said Amendment in section 3 in the 13th line by striking out the underlined figure "\$12.50" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$11' and in the 15th line by striking out the underlined figure "5.50" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$4.50'

Further amend said Amendment in section 8-A by striking out all of paragraphs A and B and inserting in place thereof the following:

'A.	10-16 18 years of age.	\$±-50	\$1.75
В.	Resident hunting 16 18 years of age or older.	\$6.50	\$8.50

Further amend said Amendment in section 8-A by striking out all of paragraph F and inserting in place thereof the following:

'F. Nonresident citizen big game hunting \$46.50 \$65.50

Permits hunting for all species including bear and deer.'
