HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P.
464, L.D. 566, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase Certain Hunting and
Fishing License Fees."

Amend said Amendment by inserting at the end of the
first paragraph, before the period, the following:
'and to Provide for Reimbursement to the Department of Inland
Fisheries and Game for Certain Services Rendered'

Further amend said Amendment by inserting after the
4th paragraph the following:

'Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §1907 is enacted to read:
§1907. Reimbursement of Department by Department of Environmental
Protection and by the Land Use Regulation Commission
The Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game shall,
during the first week in January and during the first week in July
of each year, certify to the Chairman of the Land Use Regulation
Commission the cost during the previous 6 months of all services
rendered by personnel of the Department of Inland Fisheries and
Game to the Land Use Regulation Commission and certify to the
Department of Environmental Protection the cost during the previous
6 months of all services rendered to the Department of Environmental
Protection. The Land Use Regulation Commission and the Department
of Environmental Protection shall each, within 30 days after receipt
of that certification, transfer to the Inland Fisheries and Game
Fund funds sufficient to reimburse the Department of Inland
Fisheries and Game for the total cost of services provided to the

Land Use Regulation Commission or to the Department of Environmental Protection respectively.'

Further amend said Amendment by striking out all of section 3.

Further amend said Amendment by striking out all of the last underlined paragraph of section 11.

Further amend said Amendment by striking out all of sections 12 and 13.

Further amend said Amendment by renumbering sections of the Amendment to read consecutively.

Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes certain fee increases contained in the Committee Amendment and provides for ^{the} Land Use Regulation Commission and ^{the} Department of Environmental Protection to reimburse the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game for the cost of services rendered by fish and game personnel to the Land Use Regulation Commission and the Department of Environmental Protection.
