H. P. 464, L.D. 566, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase Certain Hunting and
Fishing License Fees."

Amend said Amendment by inserting at the end of section $\epsilon\textsc{-A}$ the following:

\$29.50

'H. Serviceman's big game

permits any person serving
in the Armed Forces of the
United States who is
permanently stationed at
a military or naval post,
station or base within the
State to hunt big game.'

Further amend said Amendment by inserting at the end of section 9 the following:

'H. Serviceman's seasonal fishing
permits any person serving in
the Armed Forces of the United

States who permanently stationed
at a military or naval post,
station or base within the State
to fish during the season for
which the license is issued.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment establishes a special big game hunting license category, with a license fee of \$29.50, which permits big game hunting by any person serving in the Armed Forces of the United States who is permanently stationed at a military or naval post, station or base within this State. This amendment also establishes a seasonal fishing license category, with a license fee of \$10.50, for the same class of serviceman.
