SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to  
H.P. 464, L.D. 566, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase Certain  
Hunting and Fishing License Fees."

Amend said amendment by inserting at the end of section  
8-A the following:

'H. Serviceman's big game \$13.50

Permits any person serving  
in the Armed Forces of the  
United States who is permanently  
stationed at a military or naval  
post, station or base within the  
State, that person's spouse and  
that person's children to hunt big  
game.'

Further amend said amendment by inserting at the end  
of section 9 the following:

'H. Serviceman's seasonal fishing \$8.50

Permits any person serving in  
the Armed Forces of the United  
States who is permanently stationed  
at a military or naval post, station  
or base within the State, that person's  
spouse and that person's children to  
fish during the season for which the  
license is issued.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment establishes a special big game hunting  
license category, with a license fee of \$13.50, which permits  
big game hunting by any person serving in the Armed Forces of  
the United States who is permanently stationed at a military

or naval post, station or base within this State. This amendment also establishes a seasonal fishing license category, with a license fee of \$8.50, for the same class of serviceman. These license fees are the same as resident fees for the same categories.
