COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 181,
L. D. 582, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Possession
of Intoxicating Liquor by Persons under 18
Years of Age in On-sale Premises."

Amend said Bill in the 5th line (same in
L.D.) by striking out the underlined words
"in his possession" and inserting in place
thereof the underlined words 'on his or her
person'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to
clarify the intent of the bill which is to
prevent persons under 18 years of age from
bringing intoxicating liquor on his or her
person into any on-sale premises.
