## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Lights on Motor Vehicles of State Liquor Inspectors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 29 MRSA § 1368, sub-§ 2, as amended by PL 1973, c. 31, is further amended to read:
- 2. Police department vehicles. Lights used on police department vehicles and on motor vehicles operated by chiefs of police, state fire inspectors, state liquor inspectors, inland fisheries and game wardens, sea and shore fisheries wardens, Baxter State Park rangers, sheriffs and deputy sheriffs shall emit a blue beam of light.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

Liquor inspectors are assisting at the scene of accidents assisting police on emergency calls, etc. and at present have amber lights which are ignored by the public.
