COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 387, L. D. 587, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize the Director of the Bureau of Parks and Recreation to Prohibit the Use of Canoes with Motors on Part of the Allagash Wilderness."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 4th and 5th lines (same in L. D.) the underlined words "where prohibited by rule or regulation of the bureau" and inserting in place thereof the following 'on Allagash Lake and Allagash Stream'

This amendment is to clarify the statutes to specifically prohibit the use of any canoes with motors on Allagash Lake and Allagash Stream.
