STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Concerning Employment in the Department of Mental Health and Corrections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

34 MRSA § II is enacted to read:

§ 11. Abuse of institutional residents

Any person found civilly or criminally guilty of mental, physical or sexual abuse of an individual residing in or confined to any health care facility, mental health institution or penal institution shall be ineligible for employment in any state institution administered by the Department of Mental Health and Corrections.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this bill is to protect residents of state institutions administered by the Department of Mental Health and Corrections from abuse by state employees.
