STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Making A Supplemental Appropriation for the Supplemental Security Income Programs for the Purpose of Increasing the Base Rate for Boarding Home Care.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$759,840 to the Department of Health and Welfare to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:

This provides increased rates making the base rate, for all supplemental security resident recipients needing boarding home care, \$225 a month.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The base rate for smaller licensed boarding homes for state clients has not been increased since 1969. This proposed rate would be more realistic with present operational cost.
