AN ACT Relating to School Buses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 2020, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 780, § 4, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

§ 2020. Exception

School buses which are operated by a motor carrier holding a certificate of public convenience from the Public Utilities Commission, while transporting school children, shall comply with all of the requirements of school buses, except that they shall be exempted from the vehicle color requirements. School buses which are operated by a transit district shall be exempted from the provisions of this subchapter.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to clarify recently enacted legislation relative to the use of transit-type buses for the transportation of school children in the greater Portland Transit District Geographic area.
