AN ACT to Annex Hibberts Gore to Town of Somerville, County of Lincoln.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Annexation. All that parcel of land shown on "Plan of a section of the Somerville - Palermo - Washington town lines, June 1, 1974, Scale 1" = 500' by Lemuel L. Brown, File No. 240, "recorded in Plan Book 22, Page 56, Lincoln County Registry of Deeds, shown as Hibberts Gore, shall be annexed to the Town of Somerville in Lincoln County.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the purpose of this Act to annex Hibberts Gore to the Town of Somerville.
