STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Provide for Continuity of Treatment by Ambulance Personnel.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

32 MRSA § 74, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 544, § 113, is amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

Upon arrival at a hospital, ambulance personnel may continue to render treatment to such person or persons under the direction and control of a physician until the physician is of the opinion that the attendance of such personnel is no longer necessary.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to insure that licensed ambulance personnel have the legal authority to continue treatment at a hospital until such time as they can be relieved of their duties by hospital physician.
