COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 523, L.D. 640, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Procedures for State Valuation."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated "\$208." by striking out all of the 3rd underlined sentence.

Further amend said Bill in section 2 in that part designated <u>"§292.</u>" by inserting after the 3rd paragraph the following:

'In the event a municipality's appeal to the Superior or Supreme Judicial Court results in a lowering of the municipality's State state valuation, the Treasurer of / shall reimburse with funds appropriated from the General Fund an amount equal to the moneys lost by the municipality due to the use by the State of an incorrect state valuation in any statutory formula used to distribute state funds to municipalities.'

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are to:

Remove from the bill the provision that restricts
the Bureau of Property Taxation from increasing by more than
10% in any biennium the state valuation of any municipality.

2. To insure that if the Municipal Valuation Appeals Board incorrectly determines a municipality's state valuation, then that municipality will receive from the State whatever moneys were improperly collected by the State through such valuationbased formulae as the uniform school tax.
