STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Prohibit Insurance Policies from Requiring Premium Prepayment for more than 3 Months in Advance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

24-A MRSA § 2438 is enacted to read:

§ 2438. Prepayment not to be required

No insurance policy subject to this Title shall require prepayment of the premiums for that policy for more than 3 months in advance.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act prohibits an insurer from issuing an insurance policy subject to Title 24-A which requires prepayment of the premiums for more than 3 months in advance.
