COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 195, L. D. 645, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Labeling of Shrimp."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 3rd and 4th lines (same in L.D.) the underlined words "to list, advertise, sell or offer for sale any processed" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'process and package'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to accomplish the intent of this bill that all shrimp packaged and processed in Maine be labeled as to the country or state of origin.
