AN ACT Relating to the Labeling of Shrimp.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 4467 is enacted to read:

§ 4467. Labeling of shrimp

It is unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to list, advertise, sell or offer for sale any processed shrimp, unless the country or state of origin is clearly marked on the container.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to protect the reputation of Maine shrimp from inferior shrimp products of other states.
