COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 531, L. D. 649, Bill, "AN ACT Clarifying Sprinkler System Requirements in Boarding Homes and Existing Places of Assembly."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first underlined sentence after the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Automatic sprinkler systems shall not be required in boarding homes having 6 or less boarders or lodgers and existing noncommercial places of assembly.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment exempts all existing noncommercial places of assembly from the sprinkler system requirement, regardless of how often the place of assembly is used.
