**AN ACT Providing Compensation for Members of Inland Fisheries and
Game Advisory Council.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 1955, 4th sentence, is amended to read:

The members of the advisory council shall receive ~~no compensation~~ \$25 per diem for their services, ~~but~~ and said council shall be allowed actual expenses not to exceed \$2,000 for each fiscal year.

FISCAL NOTE

It is estimated that enactment of this bill would increase the annual expenses of the Council by approximately \$1,000.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to compensate the 7 members of the advisory council of the Maine Department of Inland Fisheries and Game for several meetings during each year which require at least a full day's attendance.
