SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 189, L.D. 662,  
Bill, "AN ACT Creating the Dickey-Lincoln Power  
Authority."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end  
before the Statement of Fact the following:

'§3623. Effect

This Act shall take effect only if the  
following conditions are satisfied:

1. The Army Corps of Engineers economic  
feasibility study being undertaken during 1975  
and 1976 on the construction of a hydroelectrical  
power project located chiefly at Dickey and the  
Lincoln School on the St. John River reports, as  
the outcome of that study, a favorable cost-  
benefit ratio to the construction of that project;

2. The Army Corps of Engineers environmental  
impact study being undertaken during 1975 and 1976  
on the environmental impact of a hydroelectrical  
power project located chiefly at Dickey and the  
Lincoln School on the St. John River reports that  
the outcome of that study is favorable; and

3. That, within one year after the completion  
of the studies specified in subsections 1 and 2,  
the United States Government has not committed  
itself to construct a hydroelectric power project  
located chiefly at Dickey and the Lincoln School on  
the St. John River.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment ensures that the bill will  
create a "standby authority," that is, an authority  
which is only activated upon favorable reports of  
the Army Corps of Engineers Economic Feasibility

and Environmental Impact Studies and only if the Federal Government does not undertake the project itself within one year of the completion of these 2 studies.
