SENATE AMENDMENT" B " to SP 189, LD 662, Bill, "AN ACT Creating the Dickey-Lincoln Power Authority."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated "§3619."

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 3620 to 3622 to be sections 3619 to 3621.

Statement of Fact

This amendment is intended to remove from the bill possible constitutional problems concerning the proposed use under section 3619 of Maine's Public Lots for the Dickey-Lincoln Project. Because the Articles of Separation of Maine from Massachusetts have been incorporated into our Constitution, and because those Articles of Separation place limitations upon the use which can be placed upon the public lots, there is a serious question whether or not the proposed uses for the public lots under LD 662 are constitutional. This amendment, striking out section 3619, removes that constitutional question.
