STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Require the Commissioner of Agriculture to Report Yearly to the Legislature on Methods of Stimulating and Encouraging the Growth and Modernization of Agricultural Enterprises.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

7 MRSA § 2, sub-§ 5 is enacted to read:

5. Report. Report and make recommendations to each Legislature with respect to methods of stimulating and encouraging the growth and modernization of agricultural enterprises in this State. Such report shall be made available to the Legislature by November 1st of each year and, for purposes of obtaining information, the Department of Agriculture may hold public hearings throughout the State, after giving public notice thereof.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The Purpose of this bill is to require the Commissioner of Agriculture to report yearly to the Legislature on methods of stimulating and encouraging the growth and modernization of agricultural enterprises.
