COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 557, L.D. 686, Bill, "AN ACT to Remove the Inheritance Tax Exemption for Life Insurance Proceeds in Excess of \$50,000 and to Increase the Inheritance Tax Exemption for Husbands and Wives."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out in the next to the last line (same in L.D.) the underlined figures" \$50,000" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figures' \$25,000'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out in the last line (same in L.D.) the underlined figures "\$30,000" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figures '\$20,000'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the Fiscal Note and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Fiscal Note

The enactment of section 1 of this bill would result in an increase in General Fund Revenue, the amount of which is speculative. Corporate fiduciaries and estate planning lawyers believe that this is an increasing area for revenue and it has been estimated that the increase for the next biennium might be approximately \$400,000. Section 2 of this bill would result in a loss of General Fund Revenue amounting to \$400,000 for a year.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to attempt to prevent this bill from resulting in a net revenue loss to the State General Fund..
