STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 107TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 205, L.D.695, Bill, "AN ACT to Prevent Hunting in Areas Near Dumps in Unorganized Territories and Plantations of the State."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and before the Statement of Fact and inserting in place thereof the following:

'It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt any game within 500 feet of any dumping area designated by the county commissioners which is located in the unorganized territories and plantations of that county. The county commissioners shall designate such a dump only after a public hearing preceded by 2 weeks notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the county in which the dumping area is located.

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that the bill's prohibition shall apply to dumps designated by the county commissioners of the county in which the dump is located.
