HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to S.P. 205, L.D. 695, Bill, "AN ACT to Prevent Hunting in Areas Near Dumps in Unorganized Territories and Plantations of the State."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the Statement of Fact the following:

'For the purpose of this section, a dump shall mean any land area used for storing, salvaging, processing, reducing, incinerating or disposing of rubbish and garbage.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to define the term "dump" for the purposes of this bill.
