SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 205, L.D. 695, Bill, "AN ACT to Prevent Hunting in Areas Near Dumps in Unorganized Territories and Plantations of the State."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and before the Statement of Fact and inserting in place thereof the following:

'It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt any game within 200 feet of any dumping area in the unorganized territories and plantations of this State.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment reduces the no hunting area for dumps to which the bill applies from 500 feet to 200 feet from the dump.
