**AN ACT to Prevent Hunting in Areas Near Dumps in Unorganized  
Territories and Plantations of the State.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 1202, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 118, § 2, is further amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt any game within 500 feet of any dumping area in the unorganized territories and plantations of this State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prevent the hunting of game from dumps in the unorganized territories and plantations of the State.
