COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 206, L.D. 696, Bill, "AN ACT to Permit Reimbursement of Attorney General's Cost of Investigation when a Permanent Injunction is Issued."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'In any action under this section where a permanent injunction is issued, the court may order the person against whom the permanent injunction has been issued to pay to the State the costs of the investigation of that person by the Attorney General and the costs of the suit, which funds shall be applied-in-the-earrying-out-of-this-chapter accrue to the General Fund.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that the funds paid to the State as costs of investigation and suit in cases where permanent injunctions are issued shall accrue to the General Fund.
