STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Change Limits under Small Claims Actions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

14 MRSA § 7451, as last amended by PL 1971, c. 206, § 1, is further amended to read:

§ 7451. Definitions

A "small claim" is any right of action cognizable by a court of law not involving the title to real estate in which the debt or damage claimed does not exceed \$200 \$500.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to bring cases allowable under small claims cases to a more realistic figure consistent with present day prices.
