AN ACT to Amend the Municipal Public Employees Labor Relations Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

25 MRSA § 965, sub-§ 1, ¶ A, as enacted by PL 1969, c. 424, § 1, is amended to read:

A. To meet at reasonable times. Meetings between public employers of teachers and bargaining agents representing teachers for collective bargaining purposes shall be open to the public at the request of either party, except that members of the public shall not participate in the discussions;

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would permit collective bargaining sessions between teachers and school boards to be open to the public.
