COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 562, L.D. 701, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Absentee Balloting in Municipal Elections."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 2. 30 MRSA §2062, sub-§2 is enacted to read:

2. Absentee ballot. The absentee ballot requirements of Title 21, section 1252, shall apply, provided that the words "Absentee Ballot" may be marked conspicuously, instead of printed, on both sides of the folded ballot, if at least one such marking includes an attestation with the written signature of the clerk and is sealed with the municipal seal.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow marking of the identifying words "Absentee Ballot," instead of requiring them to be printed.
