## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Absentee Balloting in Municipal Elections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 2062, first ¶, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 536, § 2, is further amended to read:

When any If a town which has accepted section 2061 accepts this section at a meeting held at least 60 days before the annual meeting, absentee ballots may be cast at all regular and special elections of town officials at which section 2061 is applicable, including elections for town meeting members where the representative town meeting form of government is used. Section 2001 and this section may be accepted at the same meeting

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to require all municipalities using the section 2061 secret ballot in their municipal elections to permit the casting of absentee ballots for elections of municipal officials and for referendum questions.
