AN ACT to Increase the Maximum Permitted Compensation of Directors of School Administrative Districts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

20 MRSA § 302, last ¶, first sentence, as repealed and replaced by PL 1969, c. 140, is amended to read:

The school directors shall determine their compensation, not less than \$5 and not to exceed ~~\$10~~ \$20, for the services for each board meeting that each attends.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide for an increase from \$10 to \$20 in the maximum permitted compensation of school directors.
