SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 573, L.D. 708, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Playing Card Games for Prizes."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of the
first sentence of subsection 3 of that part designated "§339."
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Except when a license is not required as provided in section
331, the fee for a license to conduct a raffle shall be \$5.'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by inserting in the
first sentence of that part designated "§341." and after the
words "except that a raffle chance" the following underlined
words and punctuation: ', whether the raffle is licensed or
whether it is not licensed as authorized by section 331.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to bring the law into
accord with the provisions of Senate Amendment "A" to H.P. 316,
L.D. 394.
