HOUSE            AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 494, L.D. 724, Bill, "AN ACT  
Creating the Maine Health Maintenance Organization Act."

Amend said Bill by inserting in subparagraph (2) of  
paragraph A of subsection 1 of that part designated "\$4204."  
after the underlined words "State Comprehensive Health Planning  
Agency" the following: 'or any successor agency'

Further amend said Bill by inserting the following  
sentence at the end of subsection 1 of that part designated  
"\$4206." 'Within one year after the issuance of a certificate  
of authority, at <sup>least</sup> 1/3 of the governing body shall consist of  
persons elected by the enrollees.'

Statement of Fact

Comprehensive health planning may be replaced in a federal  
reorganization of health agencies. This amendment ensures that  
any succeeding comprehensive health planning will assume its role  
as described in this section of the bill. In addition, this  
amendment provides election of at least 1/3 of the membership  
of the governing body within one year after the issuance of any  
certificate of authority.
