# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT to Amend the Charter of Erskine Academy.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P & SL 1891, c. 292, § 1, is amended to read:

Sec. 1. Corporators; corporate name; purposes. John K. Erskine, W. J. Thompson, S. C. Starrett, Dana C. Hanson, of China, Maine, their associates and successors, are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate by name of the Trustees of the Erskine Academy in China, Maine, and by that name shall have the power to take and hold real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding thirty five thousand dollars for the purpose of establishing and maintaining an academy for the education of youth in common, higher English, scientific and classical studies, in China, and shall be authorized to receive, hold and manage all such gifts and grants as shall be made to them for that purpose.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act will remove the limit of \$35,000 on the power of the trustees of Erskine Academy to take and hold real and personal estate for certain purposes.
