STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Giving Away of Deer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2355, sub-§ 5, first sentence is repealed as follows:

It shall be lawful for the owner of any legally registered deer to give away not to exceed 1/2 of said deer

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to allow a hunter, who lawfully kills a deer and lawfully registers said deer, to legally give away any amount of said deer.
