HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P.
212, L.D. 739, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Maine Veterinary Practice."

Amend said Amendment in that part designated "\$4854."
by striking out all of the first underlined sentence and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'There is established in the Department of Agriculture a State
Board of Veterinary Medicine, which shall consist of 5 members,
appointed by the Commissioner of Agriculture, all of whom shall
be licensed Maine veterinarians who are residents of this State,
graduates of a veterinary school and who have been licensed to
practice veterinary medicine in Maine for the 5 years preceding their
appointment.'

Further amend said Amendment in that part designated
"\$4854." by striking all of the 3rd underlined sentence from
the end and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Hereafter, all members shall be appointed for 5-year terms.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides for a 5 member Board of Veterinary
Medicine all of whom shall be licensed Maine veterinarians.
