### STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Establishing Mandatory Sentences Upon Conviction of Trafficing in Illegal Drugs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA § 2380, last ¶ is amended to read:

Except in the case of conviction for a first offence for violation of this chapter Upon conviction, the imposition or execution of a sentence shall not be suspended. Parole shall not be granted until the minimum imprisonment herein provided for the offense shall have been served.

22 MRSA § 2389 is enacted to read:

§ 2389. Mandatory sentencing if convicted of trafficing in illegal drugs

When a person is convicted of a violation of sections 2210, 2210-A, 2212-C, 2212-E, 2262-C or 2384, the imposition and execution of the prescribed sentence shall not be suspended and probation shall not be granted.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this Act to establish mandatory sentences upon conviction of trafficing in illegal drugs.
